Professor Emeritus Dato' Dr. Lian was formerly a professor at the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Malaya (UM), Kuala Lumpur. He was conferred the Emeritus Professor title during UM's convocation in 2008. Upon his retirement, he was appointed as a member of the Board of Directors of the University of Malaya, as well as Chairman of the University of Malaya Medical Centre. He is the founding president and currently is still presiding over the College of Dental Specialists, Academy of Medicine, Malaysia. Currently, he is doing voluntary work in several charity organisations, which include the Spastic Childrens' Association of Selangor & Federal Territory and Alzheimer's Disease Foundation Malaysia. He is also an Honorary Member of the Malaysian Dental Association (MDA) and serves as a Board Member for the MDA Foundation.

Lecture: PIC – Fair or Square?

Her research interests include dental materials, dental implantology and digital dentistry.

Lecture 1: The Nutcrackers and Bruxers: Solving the Cracked Tooth Conundrum

The cracked tooth is one of the more difficult to diagnose problems in dentistry. Often, patients present in clinic with vague complaints which may not be easily identified clinically. This lecture will attempt to give an overview of the cracked tooth syndrome, its predisposing factors and management of the problem.

With the advancement of adhesive dentistry technology, the traditional way of tooth preparations for indirect restorations are evolving. This lecture will cover the various options for restorative rehabilitation of cracked teeth and discuss the merits and disadvantages of various restorative materials and techniques.
