

28th SCATE Dentist Got Talent 2021 Guideline

Aim

1. To strengthen the bond between dental practitioners and dental technicians across Malaysia.
2. To establish a two-way communication between the dentists and technicians.
3. To provide an opportunity for the participants to learn from one another.
4. To motivate and encourage the dental professionals to improve on their skills and knowledge.
5. To recognise talented and skilful dental practitioners and dental technicians

INSTRUCTION TO PARTICIPANTS

General Information

1. The competition is open to all Malaysian dentists and dental technicians.
2. Registration will be made for a team of **(2) TWO**, consisting of either a dentist and a dental technician, or 2 dentists.
3. The registration consists of these (2) TWO packages:

Package 1	Entry only for Dentist Got Talent Competition	RM400 per team
Package 2	Entry for Dentist Got Talent Competition and SCATE 2021	RM1,000 per team

4. To participate, each team is required to submit their completed entry form along with registration fee. Latest by **2nd January 2021 (Friday) 11.59pm.**
5. The competition consists of two stages, Preliminary Stage and Finale.

Preliminary Stage

1. Participants are required to submit (1) ONE Full Case Report with the topic of **Holistic Dental Care**. It should at least consist two of the following disciplines:
 - a. Restorative (compulsory)
 - i. Endodontic
 - ii. Direct and indirect restoration
 - iii. Removable prosthodontics
 - b. (1) ONE other discipline
2. The required photos documentation of the Full Case Report are:
 - a. Pre and post-op Intra and Extra oral photograph;
 - b. Tooth Preparation;
 - c. Provisional Restoration;
 - d. Final Restoration;
 - e. Post-op Review.
3. All photographs submitted must be in either .jpg or .RAW format. Simple editing like cropping, resizing, rotation, exposure, saturation, temperature, as well as merging images in a single photo are allowed. However, image manipulations such as spot editing, texture smoothing, liquefying using any software or applications such as Photoshop are prohibited. All edited photographs are to be accompanied by the original, unedited images. Failing to do so will result in disqualification.
4. All submitted cases must not contain any name, products or services of any company, entity or any third-party trademarks, logos, or promotion of any brand, product or services.
5. Each team is allowed to submit only one entry and all entries must reach us latest by **10th January 2021 (Sunday) 11.59pm**.
6. Entries submitted must not have won prizes in any other contests or published elsewhere.
7. The Organising Committee retains the right to reproduce, publish or exhibit the entries without notification or payment to the photographers, or any third party.
8. For the preliminary round, all participants will be evaluated based on the following scoring format:

REPORT WRITING
Rules and requirements of report writing followed
Necessary and important information included
Easy to read and well organized
Content clarity, concise and accuracy
Original, clear and accurate photos and radiographs printed

Rationale of treatment clearly stated and supported

Punctual submission

OVERALL CASE

History and examination summarized

Diagnostic information provided

Clinical findings and active problem identification

Justification on treatment options, chosen treatment plan and prognosis

Explanation on treatment sequence and complication, if any

Laboratory prescription

Patient instructions and follow up recommendation

Difficulty of the case

9. The top **(3) THREE** entries will enter the Finale of the competition.

Finale

1. The Grand Finale of 28th SCATE Dentist Got Talent 2021 will be held on **31st January 2021** from **11:00 to 13:00** at **Conference hall, KLCC**. All finalists will be notified by email and have to confirm their attendance within one week after the notification. Any finalist who fails to do so will be automatically disqualified.
2. During the Grand Finale, the finalists will be required to complete the tasks within **(1) ONE** hour.
3. The assigned tasks are:
 - a. crown preparation
 - b. composite build-up
 - c. wax up
4. The tasks are allowed to distribute among themselves.
5. Finalists will be able to choose from a variety of composite systems provided by the sponsors or may bring their own composite kits if desired. Finalists may bring any instrument or equipment if necessary, e.g. brushes, plastic instruments, burs or polishers.
6. For the Grand Finale, each team will be assessed by 3 independent judges. The key assessment includes (but not limited to)
 - a. crown prep
 - Path of insertion or withdrawal
 - Resistance and retention
 - Structural durability
 - Finish line
 - Margin and adaptation
 - Contour and structural stability
 - Occlusion
 - polish
 - b. composite build-up
 - Form
 - Shade
 - Contour and surface texture
 - Characterization and intensives
 - Optical properties
 - Polishing and finishing
 - Overall appearance
 - c. wax up
 - Anatomy and morphology
 - Contour and surface texture
 - Symmetry
 - Polishing
7. The team which produces the best overall performance wins the competition, while the other (2) TWO teams are awarded as the 1st and 2nd runner up.

8. All Participants agree that the decision of the judges is final. The Organising Committee will not entertain any queries or challenge on the results.
9. The Organising Committee reserves the absolute right to disqualify any individual/team that is deemed to be tampering with the entry process or operation of the Competition, or in breach or potential breach of the Competition's Rules and Regulations.
10. The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel, modify, postpone, suspend or delay the Competition in the event of any unforeseen circumstances.
11. By participating in this Competition, all Eligible Participants hereby warrant that all statements, personal details given are true, correct, accurate and complete and that they have read and understood all the Rules and Regulations of this Competition and agree to be unconditionally bound by it.
12. By participating in this Competition, all Eligible Participants agree to defend, indemnify and hold the Organising Committee harmless from and against any suits, claims, losses, damages and expenses, including reasonable legal fees that may arise from or in connection with the Competition.
13. The Organising Committee reserves the right to change, amend, delete or add to any of these Rules and Regulations without prior notice and the Eligible Participants will be bound strictly to such changes.
